THEME OF THIS SUNDAY: How to answer the call of Christ.

The gospel of today tells us what should characterise our answer to the call of Christ: immediacy, generosity and a determination to change our life. The first reading links up with this not so much through the example of Jonah, but through the example of the people of Nineveh who respond positively when called upon to repent. The second reading stresses that we have very little time at our disposal and we need to use it well. Our life is precious and we cannot run the risk of spoiling it by rejecting Christ when he calls us.
